Updates

- **Added Rolling Averages**
 - Insight into best and worst returns for selected rolling periods of interest
 - Each period overlaps the next, separated by one month, across life of fund
 - Rolling periods are 1, 3, 5, 10 and 20 years, as applicable
- **Added WatchLists**
 - Save up to 25 Symbols in up to 10 Watchlists for later use
 - Can create, edit, delete and run MultiSearch from new Portfolios page
- **Redesigned Commentary Page**
 - Now uses WordPress commentary format like that of MFO main site
- **New Metrics and Parameters**
 - Category Average of Monthly Returns; R vs Peer, vs SP500, vs USBond, vs ACIUS; Fund of Funds; Include Averages, Include Indexes; Trust, Share Class, Full Name
- **Site Improvements**
 - Sliding displays make appearance more compact, especially text background
 - Definitions added to MultiSearch headers, views on hover
 - Consistency in format across tools, button labels, etc.



Planned Improvements

- **Lipper's more modern datafeed**
 - Holdings data
 - Benchmarks
- **Portfolio storage**
 - Assignable holdings allocation
 - Risk & performance metrics at portfolio level
- **Search criteria storage**
- **Multi-period MultiSearch display**
- **Other metrics ...**
 - Fund Flows, Trend, Up/Down Capture, Additional Periods
- **Plotting**
 - Evaluating AnyChart, Flot, KoolChart

Background

- Internal research to identify funds that minimized downside performance across full market cycles
 - MAXDD, Ulcer Index, Martin Ratio, Recovery Time
 - Evaluation periods of interest, like from November 2007 to present ... or from August 2000 to October 2007
- Not readily available from tradition services, like Morningstar
- So, we created the tools ourselves
- Continue to find other metrics/ratings not readily available
 - Three Alarm Funds, Fund Family Scorecard, Correlation
 - Several beta testers help enhance ... Thank you!
- Realized such tools may be of interest to other investors and financial advisers



Premium Pages

- **MultiSearch**

- Main tool with nearly 70 search criteria, across 21 evaluation periods
- Pre-set Screens, Risk Profile, Correlation Matrix, Rolling Averages

- **Score Card**

- Fund family ratings based on absolute return vs peers

- **Three Alarm**

- Legacy site Fund Alarm ratings (Three Alarm and Honor Roll)
- Based on absolute return vs peers

- **Great Owls**

- Based on risk-adjusted return vs peers

- **Definitions**

- **Portfolios**

- Up to 10 WatchList of up to 25 funds

- **Dashboard**

- Quick look summary of 120 funds profiled by David, mostly

- **Commentary**

- Expands upon and previews our monthly main site

- **Averages**

- Summary of 155 category risk and return averages across 10 periods

- **Welcome**

- Summary or latest updates and samples of site contents

- **Login/Account**



Implementation

- Lipper Data Feed Service (LDFS) for U.S. Open End funds
 - Updated monthly on 4th business day
 - 10,000 funds (29,000 all share class), including 2,000 ETFs, across 155 investment categories, plus 5,000 indexes
 - Database begins January 1960, surviving funds only
- All performance and risk metrics computed internally from monthly total return data
 - 2000 parameters for each fund ... always growing!
- Site maintained using standard web languages
 - DataTables output and Select2 styling (Open source MIT license)
 - UserBase by Encodable provides login/account manager
 - SiteGround is web host
 - Optimized for Chrome, but AOK on IE, Edge, Firefox, Safari ... iPad/iPhone



Qualifications

- Screeners are quantitative only
 - MultiSearch, ThreeAlarm, HonorRoll, Great Owls, Fund Family Ratings
 - Only “David’s Take” from main site profiles are qualitative
- Metrics based strictly on historical fund performance
 - Backward looking, past performance
- No accounting for survivorship bias
- No accounting for style drift
- No accounting for management or strategy changes
